May 14, 2020

On May 14, 2020, the Versailles Town Council held a virtual meeting via Zoom. A verbal roll call was taken. Council members Roxanne Meyer, Josh Combs, Steve Mathes, Attorney Lynn Fledderman, Clerk-Treasurer Kiersten Libby, and guest John Santen were in attendance. The council unanimously adopted the April minutes.

The press was notified, public comment was suspended, and critical town matters only were to be discussed.

APV claims and the payroll dockets will be signed by the council.

Roxanne discussed the possibility of bringing the street department crew all back full time. The council agreed that the street crew should wear masks when in close proximity, but masks are not necessary when they are distanced. All shared equipment will be sanitized, and no more than two employees per vehicle.

A water loss audit will be conducted every even year. Curry and associates will provide the necessary information to IDEM. Curry provided a quote of under \$1,000 for their work.

The council discussed the possibilities for financing the new water line on Benham Rd. Attorney Lynn Flederman explained the bond process. The Tyson Fund could purchase the bond, and forgive the town's payments, or perhaps contribute a lump sum of money. Lynn has spoke with Dean Rogers and he will email a service agreement to outline bond costs.

With no further business coming before the council, the meeting adjourned at 7:26 p.m.
