

May 9, 2023

On May 9, 2023, the Versailles town council met for their regular monthly meeting. All council members and attorney Lynn Fledderman were in attendance. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

Steve Buffington appeared before the council to request to close First North and Main Street around the bike shop for a bike show on May 20th. Council approved.

Ben Sieverding reported that the fire department responded to 47 calls in April and 26 calls so far in May. He noted 3 major structure fires and 2 serious medical calls. The department received \$6222 from the letter campaign.

Department reports were received prior to the meeting and were read and reviewed by council. Items on the consent agenda were accepted.

The county has agreed to host an EV Charging station and are waiting for a response from Duke Energy.

Ordinance 2023-3 amending and restating the ordinance creating the Rainy Day fund was approved and signed.

Ordinance 2023-4 establishing a Community Crossings Grant Fund was approved and signed.

A Resolution Regarding the Courthouse Clock Tower was tabled pending further discussion with the County.

REMC submitted a request for a utility easement on County Rd 50 W. Council unanimously approved.


Lindsey Elston requested use of Pangburn Park July 17-21 from 11:00-12:30 pm. Council approved unanimously.

An update to the Community Center Ordinance was discussed. Ordinance will be reviewed and updated before being brought back for discussion.



Items that were discussed with no immediate resolution were Lawyer Excavation quote to upgrade Pollard's Lift Station, Holman Excavation quote to move sewer line on US 50 for the culvert project, and a Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area. All were tabled awaiting further information.


With no further business coming before the council, the meeting adjourned at 7:42 p.m.
