Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on November 9, 2012. All council members and attorney Larry Eaton were present. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Fire Chief Ben Sieverding reported 34 calls since the last meeting. Chief Sieverding informed the council that the new emergency sirens have been delivered, and will be installed soon. Duke energy has offered to donate either the polls for the sirens or the labor to install them.

Steve Mathes announced that INDOT has approved the planning grant for the proposed walking/bike trails. INDOT would like to set up a meeting to present the check for the trails in the next few months. Steve asked Attorney Eaton if he had followed up with the American Legion on the easement between the town hall and the Legion. Attorney Eaton spoke with Roger Kavanaugh, and the council will meet with the Legion members and Surveyor Jeff French to outline what will be decided to the Legion.

John Holzer will get an estimate from Hughes Tree Service for trimming the cherry trees in town.

Sue Meisberger reported for Superintendent Kevin Hensley that the new curbs by Tyson church are in, but the finish plate has not been poured yet.

With no further business coming before the council, the meeting adjourned at 7:18 p.m.
