Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on February 9, 2012. All council members and Attorney Larry Eaton were present. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Minutes from the previous meeting were read & approved.

Jennifer Sturgeon from Horst Feathers TLC was in attendance to update the town on the organization's progress. They would like to be up and running by spring. Ms. Sturgeon requested that the town waive water and sewer tap fees. The council voted 3-0 to waive the fees once the program is running.

Jodi Comer from SIRPC presented the council with information on the sanitary sewer and storm drain planning grant. Midwestern engineering will have a contract in order for the town to review before the next meeting.

Ben Sieverding from the Versailles Volunteer Fire Department reported 23 calls since the last meeting. Ben asked the council for assistance with the cost of reprogramming the emergency sirens. John suggested that he get some estimates.

Sandy Whitehead from Rumpke requested information on the town's current trash contract.

Marshall Joe Mann informed the council that a new lock has been installed on the door at the former firehouse. The council congratulated Marshall Mann on recent arrests made.

Superintendent Kevin Hensley reported two water leaks. The town streets were salted four times. The street department also trimmed some of the cherry trees in town. Kevin would like to buy a welder for the town. John motioned to purchase the welder for \$1,159.00, motion passed 3-0.

John would like to get estimates for installing plumbing at Tyson Auditorium. A motion was made to accept a bid from Federman's if it is feasible to install bathrooms. Motion passed 3-0.

With no further business coming before the council, the meeting adjourned at 7:31 p.m.
