

April 19, 2012

Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for a special meeting on April 19, 2012 at 6 p.m. All council members were present.

Mike Daugherty and Roger Kavanaugh were in attendance to represent the Versailles American Legion. Mr. Kavanaugh expressed concern that if the town hall was sold, the future owner could possibly deny the Legion access to through the back part of the building. Council member Steve Mathes said that the council would walk through with some of the legion members and resolve the issue in writing, even though currently there are no plans to sell the town hall.

School Resources Officer Dan Goris asked the town council if there was a possibility for him to work part time for the town for approximately six weeks while school is out. The council asked Marshall Joe Man for his thoughts. Officer Mann stated that if the council would approve a part time officer it would be very beneficial. Council member John Holzer motioned to allow Officer Goris to work 20 hours per week through the summer. Motion passed unanimously.

The council members discussed possible options for the old firehouse. The council agreed to put the old Sonoco station lot up for sale. John has also been speaking with an individual who is interested in purchasing Tyson Auditorium. It was decided that if both properties sell for \$15,000 and \$68,000 respectively, the town would use the funds toward the remodeling project. The town will also request money from the Tyson Fund and pursue any grants available to supplement the cost.

With no further business coming before the council, the meeting was adjourned.

The council held an executive session to discuss personnel issues.
