## October 10, 2013

Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on October 10, 2013. Council member John Holzer and President Sue Meisberger were present. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Fire Chief Ben Sieverding reported 46 calls since the last meeting. Ben informed the council that the fire department has received a \$3,500 grant from the Rising Sun Regional Foundation. The department has been teaching local children about fire prevention.

Marshall Joe Mann reported that the police department has donated \$1,000 to the Tyson Activity Center to purchase a training mat. In turn, the department will be permitted to use the building and the mat for training. Marshall Mann asked the council if the town could donate an old piano and organ to the Tyson Activity Center. John motioned to donate both, Sue 2<sup>nd</sup>, motion passed 2-0. SRO Jeff Thielking will be attending training in December.

Superintendent Kevin Hensley reported that Graham Creek lift station had a transfer switch go out. Leaves will be picked up every Monday and Thursday from October 21-November 25. Last day for limb pick up will be November 3. Kevin would like to hire a street cleaning company to sweep the streets. The cost is \$2,200 per year for twice per year service. John motioned to approve, Sue 2<sup>nd</sup>, motion passed 2-0.

Clerk-Treasurer Kiersten Libby presented the 2014 budget for approval. Budget was approved unanimously.

John Holzer reported that 5 individuals had attended the Mainstreet meeting with Erica Speer. The Mainstreet committee is under way.

Sue Meisberger presented a letter from IDEM stating that everything is fine with the water.

With no further business coming before the council, meeting adjourned at 7:14 p.m.
