Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on November 14, 2013. Council member Steve Mathes and President Sue Meisberger, and attorney Larry Eaton were present.

Marshall Joe Mann spoke about purchasing exercise equipment for the town employees. It was decided not to do so. The police department gave out approximately 600 glow sticks for Halloween. Officer Jeff Thielking is working out well for the department.

Superintendent Kevin Hensley reported that Graham Creek lift station is fixed, and additional work at the sports complex has been completed. Kevin also reported that an employee has resigned from the street department as of November 22. Larry recommended checking with other towns on the competitiveness of salaries and benefits. Kevin will draft a job description for the council to review. Upon approval, the job will be posted. All applicants will be interviewed by Kevin and the town board. Background checks and drug testing are stipulations of employment. Kevin also discussed the accident he was involved in. He was rear ended by a Versailles resident. The resident's insurance will pay for damages.

Steve Mathes asked about furthering the Mainstreet program. Steve said he would follow up with some of the attendees. The town may be of assistance for meeting place, etc.
