Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on March 14, 2013. All council members and attorney Larry Eaton were present. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mary McCarty from SIRPC presented a resolution to adopt plans for the sewer study. The resolution passed 3-0. The possible purchase of camera equipment for videoing the sewer lines was discussed. The equipment can be financed for five years, with payment delayed for one year. The total cost for refurbished equipment is \$69,200. Mary will look into possible grant funding for purchasing the equipment.

Marshall Joe Mann reported that he has issued six ordinance violations.

Superintendent Kevin Hensley said that the fields at the sports complex had been re-seeded. The fields will need additional work, as they are not draining properly. Superintendent Hensley met with Midwest Engineers to discuss the results of the video work they have done. A manhole needs to be set at Pollard's lift station.

Clerk-Treasurer Kiersten Libby presented the Ripley County Community Foundation Quality of Life Fund distribution letter. The council agreed unanimously to roll the distribution over into the fund as in years past.

With no further business coming before the council, the meeting adjourned at 8:12 p.m.
