

July 11, 2013

Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on July 11, 2013. Council members Sue Meisberger and Steve Mathes were present. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Fire Chief Ben Sieverding reported that the new sirens were being tested around town.

Marshall Joe Mann reported that he would be the head of security for the Samantha Hansen benefit at the Osgood Fair Grounds on July 13, 2013.

Superintendent Kevin Hensley reported that the trees on North Adams street and 2<sup>nd</sup> North street had been cut down. New mulch has been delivered to the Pangburn Park playground. 11 manholes around town have been rehabbed, and the new safety harness device was delivered and is working well.

The council presented a letter from Officer Dan Goris stating that he will be resigning as the School Resources Officer and from the Town of Versailles. Steve praised officer Goris' performance as the School Resources Officer and stated that a replacement will be sought to continue the SRO program.

Steve motioned to donate \$200 to the Samantha Hansen scholarship fund through the Ripley County Community Foundation, motion passed 2-0. Steve also motioned to have name badges made for the utilities employees, motion passed 2-0. Steve motioned to raise the clothing allowance for street employees from \$175 to \$200, motion passed 2-0. A bid was presented from Hughes Tree Service for trimming the cherry trees in town. The total cost is \$2700 and the town will be reimbursed by the Versailles Historical Preservation Society.

With no further business coming before the council, meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
