Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on August 9, 2013. All council members and attorney Larry Eaton were present. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Fire Chief Ben Sieverding reported 18 calls since the last meeting. Six members of the Versailles Volunteer Fire Department will be participating in a full scale drill at Mascatatuck on August 27. The drill is preparation for disaster emergencies.

Jeff Hamm from the sports complex board reported that the dugouts should be finished at the park soon. The Masonic Lodge has been contracted to run concessions for soccer for the 2013 season. William Tewmey requested that one of the security lights at the park be turned because it is shining directly into his home. Kevin Hensley will contact REMC and ask if it can be moved.

Superintendent Kevin Hensley reported that the pump at the dam needs to be repaired. Employee Karl Ruble has resigned and will not be replaced at this time.

Clerk-Treasurer Kiersten Libby presented the inter-local agreement from the RCED. The council accepted the agreement unanimously.

Steve Mathes mentioned that the town is still seeking volunteers to serve on the Mainstreet committee. A meeting will be organized for those interested once there are enough volunteers.

Sue Meisberger presented a letter from Lifetime Resources requesting ideas for funding for the meals on wheels program. Sue suggested they contact local churches.

With no further business coming before the council, the meeting adjourned at 7:24 p.m.
