

January 9, 2017

Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on January 9, 2017. All council members, and attorney Larry Eaton were present. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Steve Mathes opened the bids for the storm drain project. The figures were read by John Wetzel of Midwest Engineering. Midwest will review the figures, and the project will be awarded to the lowest bidder.

Cheryl Richmond presented the figures for the Versailles Town Court.

Fire Chief Ben Sieverding reported 31 calls since the last meeting. Ben also reported that the board of directors for the VVFD voted not to put any more money into repairing the old engine. Ben presented the 2016 annual report.

Superintendent Kevin Hensley reported that a 1500 gallon tank has been removed from the water plant. The roads were salted once. The council voted unanimously to remove a tree by the property located at 234 S. Main Street.

Marshal Joe Mann informed the council that one of the cameras at Pangburn Park has been vandalized. Marshal Mann requested that the council consider purchasing a new police vehicle. Steve Mathes stated that the council would have to review the options.

Ordinance # 2017-01 regarding the employee payroll passed unanimously. Steve motioned to elect Roxanne Meyer council president, and Brian Samples Vice President. Both motions carried 3-0.

Roxanne mentioned the need to update the town's total road amount.

Brian stated that the town should look into hiring a coordinator for the sports complex. This position would also be responsible for groundwork, and in the off season, help with the street department. The council will discuss a job description and salary for this position.

With no further business coming before the council, the meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
