

April 11, 2017

Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on April 11, 2017. All council members Roxanne Meyer and Brian Samples were present. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Katherine Conover informed the council that she would be opening a children's boutique at 306 S. Main Street. The projected opening is the end of May, 2017.

Judge Cheryl Richmond reported that the revenue for the court is up. The council discussed the fee schedule for court fines.

Marshal Joe Mann reported that the cameras were up and running at Pangburn Park. Marshal Mann presented quotes for a new police car. Batesville Chrysler presented a price of \$24,16 for a Dodge Charger. The council agreed unanimously to purchase the Charger.

Superintendent Kevin Hensley reported that the new mowers are in. Danny Isaacs will start tomorrow. Pangburn Park needs to be tilled to even out the field.

Attorney Eaton has received a bid for tearing down the building on the square. The town accepted a bid for the old truck in the amount of \$12,130. Camera work has been done on Clearview Lane. The street department has started picking up brush on Tuesdays. Kevin discussed the benefits of GIS software. The initial cost is \$5,675, with an annual fee of \$600. Roxanne motioned to purchase the software, motion passed 2-0.

Roxanne reported that the RCSC will sell a cooler to the town for \$100. Brian mentioned that maybe a trade could be worked out for the labor involved with moving the cooler in the first place. Kevin will get bids for a sprinkler system for the complex. Roxanne would like to display signs at the complex with rules of conduct, etc. A parking area will be created for the walking trails.

The Trash ordinance was presented for the second reading. Kevin will check prices for UTV's for the sports complex. Roxanne informed the council that Steve is working on a concessions agreement for the regular season. Mary McCarty will submit a grant to the RSRF for the soccer fields. The Pavement Access Management Plan has been submitted to INDOT. The council discussed purchasing scoreboards for the complex.

With no further business coming before the council the meeting adjourned at 8 pm.
