Be it remembered that the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on June 12, 2018. All council members were present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Marty Porter was in attendance to request a sign acknowledging his son's 2009-2010 State Bowling Championship win. The council agreed that they didn't see a problem with putting up a sign.

Ben Sieverding reported 54 calls since the May meeting. Ben requested an increase in payment for the 2019 budget. The council will consider it.

Superintendent Kevin Hensley reported that the sewer pump has been replaced at the sports complex. The truck is being repaired, and the scoreboards are being installed.

Attorney Larry Eaton has sent notices to property owners that are in violation of the lawn ordinance. Larry recommended that the town pay part of the fire contract out of the utilities. The council signed the hazard mitigation plan. There will be a special meeting on Monday, June 18 to review the rental inspection ordinance. Two hour parking signs will be reworded to specify that parking is for park participants only. The soccer fields are finished.

Steve Mathes asked Larry if there was any new information about the contract with the state park. Larry will talk with the engineer about revising the contract. Bids were opened for construction on the new town hall. Larry recommended going with the lowest bid, and speaking with Curry & Associates about revising some of the specs to reduce cost.

Roxanne Meyer asked if the town would be willing to sponsor the Jim Tyson video for the bicentennial. The council approved 3-0. Roxanne thanked Giving Hearts A Hand for the donation of a portable AED.

With no further business coming before the council, the meeting adjourned at 8:39 p.m.
