

February 14, 2023

On February 14, 2023, the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting. All council members were in attendance. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

Department reports were received prior to the meeting and were read and reviewed by council. Items on the consent agenda were accepted.

Roxanne shared attorney Lynn Fledderman's suggestion to move forward with updating ordinances online. Motion was made and carried.

The updated trash ordinance was presented and the first reading was made. The second reading will take place at the March meeting.

The town council received a request from Main Street Versailles to include a letter in March water bills asking residents for financial support of MSV's efforts. MSV will pay the town for the cost of including the letter. Motion for approval was made and carried.

Roxanne presented proposal from architect, Bob Powell, to create renderings for a façade update for the town hall. Funding for completing the updates will be pursued through state funds that will be available following historic district designation later in 2023 and grants. Motion to approve was made and carried.

Tyson Library requested permission to close Tyson Street between High Street and Adams Street on June 10<sup>th</sup> for a summer library program – Touch-a-Truck. Motion to approve was made and carried.


Randall Miller presented needs and cost for flow meter and gearbox replacements at the sewer plant. Motion to approve was made and carried.

The town's annual agreement for participation in Ripley County Economic Development was signed.




With no further business coming before the council, the meeting adjourned at 7:57 pm.
