On November 11, 2025, the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting. All Council were in attendance along with attorney Lynn Fledderman. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

Jerad Amos was present to discuss the baseball/softball program. He asked about the progress of the practice fields. Roxanne stated that it was too costly and they would not be installed this year. He also noted that updates to the fields needed to be made prior to the rec league season and he was trying to coordinate with Josh and Cane's to get a list together. Contracts were also mentioned and Roxanne suggested that a special meeting be held to discuss both programs and resolve any questions.

Jimmie Childers from Best Way was present and offered to answer any questions council may have regarding the garbage and recycling bid. At this time council had no questions.

Ben Sieverding noted that the fire department has responded to 585 calls for the year so far. Roxanne congratulated Ben on being recognized as fire fighter of the year.

Department reports were received prior to the meeting and were read and reviewed by council. Items on the consent agenda were accepted.

Holly requested approval for Flies Vandenbrink to start on bid documents for CCMG because of the new timeframe guidelines. Council approved unanimously.

Mr. Sran was present to discuss updates made to the Nobel LLC property and his plans. He has made progress on the interior and structure. He will attend the meeting next month with further updates.

Roxanne stated that quotes were received and opened for the practice fields. The quotes came in over budget.

Sarah introduced the salary ordinance for council to review prior to next month's meeting.

An executive session was held prior to the regular meeting. Council approved Holly's request for additional vacation days. They signed a letter stating how many days she will receive.


The town's health, dental and vision insurance is up for renewal. Council requested feedback from employees. They will make a decision at next month's meeting.
